

# **HB-SleeveLUX Proctoscope**

# Instructions for Use

## INTENDED USE and INDICATIONS FOR USE

HB- SleeveLUX Proctoscope is a class I self-illuminating disposable instrument used to assist clinicians when treating and/or diagnose conditions in the anal canal and the lower rectum such as  $1^{st} 2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  degree haemorrhoids.

HB-SleeveLUX Proctoscope is a clean device and non-sterile in a sealed package and is meant for one-time use only. After the use the device should be disposed of in a suitable manner in accordance with local regulations.

#### **Preparation for use**

- 1. Select the appropriate diameter of HB-SleeveLUX Proctoscope to adequately perform the treatment or diagnosis.
- 2. Remove the HB-SleeveLUX Proctoscope from the packaging and inspect for any visual damage prior to use.
- 3. Connect the main body tube to the handle.
- 4. Ensure the sleeve is over the trocar and apply a suitable lubricant to the trocar.

#### Procedure

- 1. Slowly and gradually introduce the lubricated trocar and sleeve into the anus.
- 2. Remove the trocar leaving the sleeve in the anus.
- 3. Insert the main body by aligning the locking system on the main body and sleeve. Then turn on the LED module.
- 4. The HB-SleeveLUX Proctoscope can then freely move within the sleeve with no discomfort to the patient without the need for multiple introductions.
- 5. After the procedure has been performed removed the whole device from the anus.
- 6. Once removed from the anus, easily unclip the LED module from the handle and dispose of it correctly.
- 7. The remaining device should be disposed of in the appropriate manner






Date of manufacture (yyyy-mm)
